Age Classes:

3 to 5 year olds

6 and 7 year olds

8 and 9 year olds

General Rules

All children must be signed in with both parent at the pit gates.

If both parents can't attend event, must have notarized permission slip with child.

All children must wear approved safety helmets. Bicycle helmet will pass.

If child gets out of the power wheel during event, that child is out of event.

Power Wheel Build

All Power wheel must remain stock with no added re-enforcements!

You may add a rubber tire to the tread area of the power wheel's tire for added traction.

Must use factory 12 volt battery only and must be mounted secure and covers with rubber mat.

Power Wheel Decorations

Power wheels may be decorated to look like a demo derby car, but can NOT re-enforce.

Decoration can only be made out of the following: Card board- tape- paper- etc.

Keep in mind this is for fun for the children!

Each Power wheel must have a number on each side for scoring. .

Power Wheel event

Each age group will be given a time limit.

1 parent will be allowed on the track with their child during the event.

All power wheels will be checked in at pit gate, then impounded until time for their event.

2 balloons will be furnished and attached to the front and back of the power wheel. When the child's balloons are popped, they will be eliminated from the Derby. Winner will be child with a balloon still inflated and attached.
