Floyd County Fair Queen Guidelines

- Contestants must reside in Floyd County or an adjoining county if the majority of your activities are in Floyd County. (School, 4-H, FFA, etc.)
- Contestants must be between the ages of 16 and 21, as of Aug. 13th, 2026. The first day of the Iowa State Fair.
- Contestants must never have been married or have had children.
- Each contestant must be an active member of at least one service organization in her community such as a church group, Girl Scouts, 4-H, FFA, etc. (Eligibility is not limited to 4-H or FFA membership.)
- The contestant may not be a professional model.
- All Queen Candidates are required to participate in the Floyd County Queen Competition on July 12th, 2026 @ in the Youth Enrichment Center. This includes: Formal Wear, Pageant, an Interactive Activity, and Social. (More information to follow). This is closed to contestants and Floyd County Queen Committee members and volunteers only. Coronation will be open to the public.
- All Queen Candidates must attend coronation on Tuesday, July 14th, 2026.
- The selected Queen must be prepared to spend the period of July 15-19, 2026 At the Floyd County Fair as the official hostess. This Includes shows, grandstand events, and volunteering around the grounds during the week of fair.
- The selected Queen must be able to attend the Iowa State Fair for further judging and activities, in August. Final dates will be announced as we approach the fair date.
- The selected Queen must be available and able for radio interviews at KCHA and participate in community parades in Floyd County during her reign, the next Summer!
- All Queen Candidates will be participants/riding in the Charles City 4th of July Parade.
